## Sandy Bay Mooring 8512

What better place to leave your pride and joy than right off the middle of Nutgrove Beach? Take full advantage of this mooring's central location and stock up on boutique Tasmanian food and wine, or perhaps a coffee for those early starts, from one of the many cafes or food stores in the area.

This prime location is rated to around 8m but could be increased if required. Unlike moorings further out, this one is quite secluded, being afforded considerable protection from Maning Reef, which lies to the north. Tenders can be stored above the high tide mark of the beach if you wish, with the nearest boat ramp being located at the Derwent Sailing Squadron. This mooring can be leased for short- or long-term use.

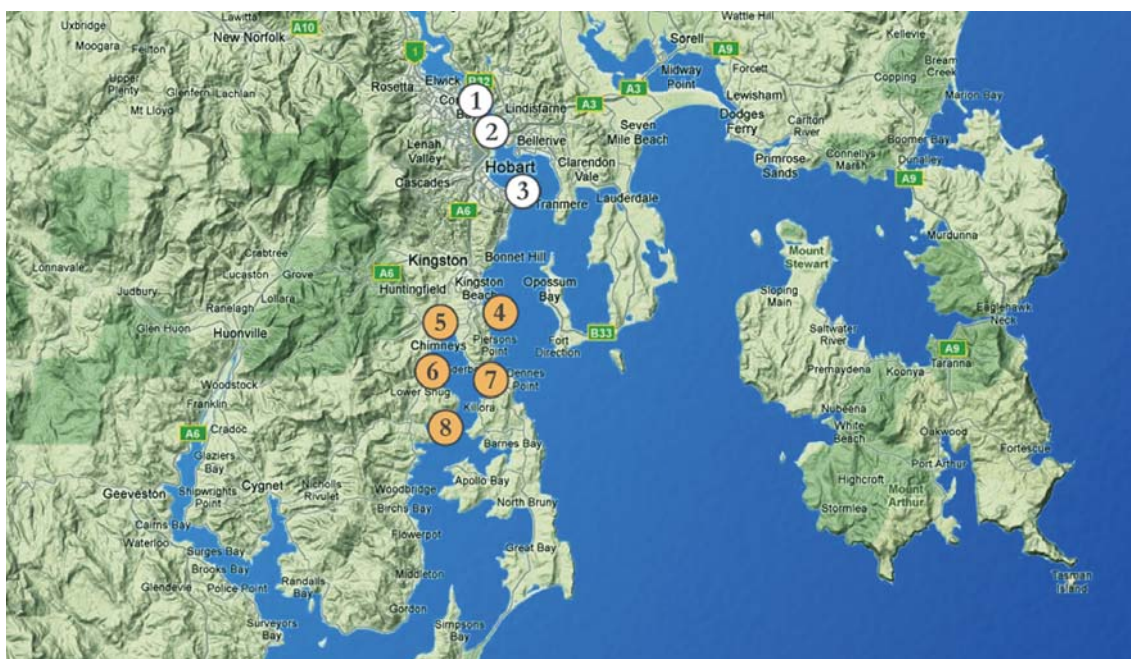
## Long-term Fees

## River Derwent and D'Entrecasteaux Region

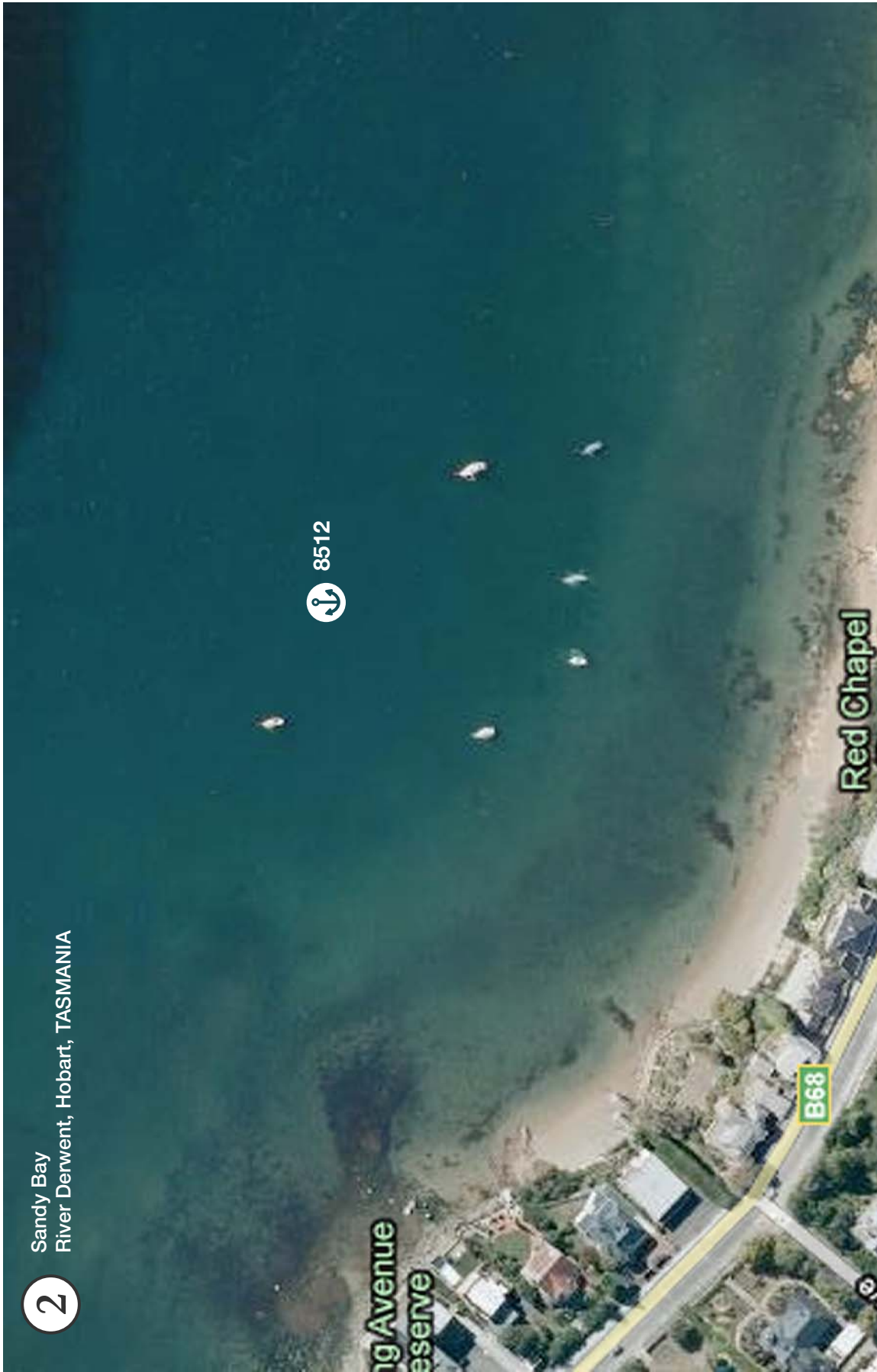


○ Long Term Moorings
